

Mason County Promise Zone Appeals Committee Meeting Minutes Monday, August 19, 2024 at 11:00 AM Lakeshore Resource Network Conference Room

- 1. Call to Order: Knizacky called the meeting to order at 11:00 AM.
- 2. Limited Public Comment: None
- 3. Approval of the Agenda: Motion by Pepper to approve the agenda, supported by Nash; Motion carried 4-0-0.
- 4. Approval of the Meeting Minutes
 - a. 6-3-2024: Motion by Nash to approve the minutes, supported by Quillan; Motion carried 4-0-0.

5. Committee Business

- a. Consideration of Student Appeals
 - i. Appeal #89—GPA: Motion by Knizacky to recommend to the full Board to approve the appeal, contingent upon the student getting a SAP appeal approved, supported by Nash; Discussion included a request for the Director to get an updated student transcript with summer grades and evaluating the student after fall 2024 for future semester appeals; Motion carried 4-0-0.
 - ii. Appeal #90—GPA: Motion by Quillan to recommend approval of appeal #90 to the full Board, supported by Nash; Discussion included whether or not a SAP should be included, and Maloney noted that SAP was not required based on this student's transcript; Motion carried 4-0-0.
 - iii. Appeal #91—GPA: Motion by Pepper to recommend to the full Board the approval of appeal #91, supported by Quillan; Discussion: Pepper wondered how the student could take Biology II without having completed Biology I and suggested that the director send a note to the registrar Jill Sweet to follow up. The Committee wondered if the student may need a SAP appeal and Maloney was unsure but will ask the student to complete if needed; Motion carried 4-0-0.
 - iv. Appeal #92—GPA: Motion by Nash to recommend to the full Board the approval of appeal #92, supported by Quillan; Discussion included that the Committee would like the student to work with a Success Coach, that they would like the student to seek SAP approval; Motion carried 4-0-0.
- b. Review of past appeal grantee student progress:
 - i. For appeals considered through summer 2023 (Of denied students, 0 are attending/graduated)
 - 1. Maloney shared that she can update this table again after January of 2025 when NSC data is available.
