Motion to recommend appeal #50 for approval by full Board by Quillan, pending receipt of SAP approval and transcript, with support from Nash; Motion carried 3-0-1.
 - v. Appeal #44: SAP—Transcript Received: Motion to recommend appeal #50 for approval by Nash, pending receipt of either approved SAP appeal or documentation that indicates that the SAP appeal is not needed, with support from Quillan; Motion carried 3-0-1.
